Team Formation

Team Formation Factors:

- # of Registrations
 - # of Teams
 - Coach Requests
 - Friend Requests
 - School
 - Age
 - Seasons Played
 - Height
 - Weight
- Every season is a new roster. You are not guaranteed to receive the same roster every season.
 - All friend/coach requests are truly requests so they are never guaranteed.
 - Max of 10 on a roster, but you are not guaranteed 10. The number allotted per roster is dependent on the factors listed. Our goal is to accommodate every request, but our main goal is to fairly distribute the number of players on each team.
 - Example - In a season of 200 participants that means 200+ requests we are trying to accommodate

Team Formation (CONTD.)

“Why am I not getting the full 10 on my team?”

The main goal of the league is to fairly distribute the amount of players per roster. The second goal is to accommodate as many requests as we can. The end result is dependant on the amount of players registered in a division.

Playing Up Requests

Playing up requirements:

For any child playing up, they have to follow the below requirements:

- Directly requested by the coach
- The parent is the head coach
- They turn the required age during the season (ex: they are 10 and turn 11 the 2nd week of the season, they can play in 12U)

All players requesting to play up must go through the athletic staff directly PRIOR to registration. They will not be able to register online due to the system parameters.

Find more information by viewing the Age Qualification Policies

As a league we highly suggest you play in the division you qualify for.

- The only exception to this suggestion is a player that has been the qualifying age for a while they just have a close birthday to September. Example - My child turned 9 on 9/12/2025 , but wants to play in the 10U division in the Spring. This player does qualify for 8U still, but this is acceptable as the player will be the correct age during the season.

Age Verification

- All individuals registered for the season must provide proof of age for age verification.
- If we do not receive proof of age, the individual will not be able to play.
- What type of document do we accept:
 - Birth Certificate
 - Passport
- How does someone submit their document?
 - Email it to playtcsports@thecolonytx.gov
 - Take it to the Recreation Center for staff to make a copy
- When is the deadline?
 - **9/5/2025**
 - Please tell your teams parents not to wait until 9/5 to submit. We usually have over 200 ages we are verifying in a summer season or spring/fall so the sooner it is submitted the better!
- Roster Notations
 - We will note on your rosters of who we still need age verification from. If it does not have a note in the birthdate verification, that means we have not received anything.
- Submitted Previously?
 - If a person has submitted previously they do NOT need to resubmit.

Coaching Paperwork

- **Background Checks**

- All coaches (head & assistant) must complete a background check.
- Checks can take up to 2 or more business days.
 - This means the sooner you submit the better!
- Rosters will not be released & teams will not to start practice until there is a cleared coach for the team.

- **Coaches Information Sheet**

- New coaches or coaches that have had contact information change must fill this out.

- **Volunteer Arrest Waiver**

- All coaches must review and sign this for the season. (Head & Assistants)
- This waiver states that you will notify us within 5 business days after an arrest.

NAYS Online Training

- This online training is MANDATORY for all head coaches to complete.
 - It is a city ordinance that all youth sports volunteer coaches must complete NAYS coaches training
 - Assistant coaches do **NOT** need to complete the training.
- What is the NAYS Training?
 - The National Alliance of Youth Sports is an organization that provides online training for youth sports for organizations across the country. These trainings educate volunteer coaches on their roles & responsibilities.
 - The trainings will take one to two hours depending on your pace. You can pause the training and return to the place you left off.
- Trainings Required
 - Coaching Youth Sports
 - Basic Youth Sports Safety & First Aid Training
 - Coaching Youth Flag Football

NAYS Online Training (Cont'd)

- The league will register and pay for your trainings and memberships.
- You will receive an email directly from NAYS once the league registers you.
 - In this email it will give you a username and temporary password to login on www.nays.org.
- The deadline to complete the training is 9/12/25.
 - If this is not completed by the deadline, the head coach will not qualify for the head coach registration reimbursement.
- If you have completed these trainings in the past you will NOT need to retake them. The only time you would need to take another training is if your are coaching a new sport or division in some cases. We will renew and pay for your memberships when applicable.

DEADLINE TO COMPLETE 9/12/ 2025

Assistant Coaches

- All teams **MUST** have at least one assistant coach.
- Anyone that is assisting you throughout the season, must go through the background check and fill out all of the required paperwork.
- **If the head coach cannot attend a game and there is not an approved assistant coach available to take over, the game will be deemed a FORFEIT. *Approved Assistant Coach = Passed Background Check**
 - **Example - If a coach is ejected from the game and they do not have an approved assistant coach the game will be deemed a forfeit at that time.**
- The league highly suggests to get your assistant coaches cleared prior to the start of the first games. This way we can avoid any possible forfeits. Do NOT wait until the week you may need them as there is no guarantee we will be able to get them cleared in time!
- **There may be a total of 3 coaches per team.**
- **Only three coaches may be on the team bench during games. *This includes the head coach.**

Coaching Responsibilities

- As the head coach it is your responsibility to communicate with your team and the league.
 - Notify the league of any issues or if you are going to miss a game.
 - It is your responsibility to make sure if you are going to miss a game you have an approved assistant coach to fill your spot.
- As the coach you are your teams role model
 - Unsportsmanlike behaviour between coaches will NOT be tolerated
 - If there is an issue you are having with a coach or official, please walk over to the score table and speak with the game supervisor directly
 - Please remember that these referees are volunteering their time to referee and are human.
 - If there is an urgent issue that needs to go higher up, please send the athletics staff an email or let the game supervisor know.

Coaches Code of Conduct Policy

- Please review the coaches code of conduct in your packet.
- It is your responsibility to follow these policies throughout the season. If they are not followed, suspensions may follow.
- Please remember we are here for the kids and for them to learn football and have fun.

Suspension Guidelines

Coaches, Players & Spectators: (ejection)

- If a coach, player or spectator is ejected from the game they will receive a one game suspension. That suspension will be enforced at the next game.
- If a coach, player or spectator is ejected for a second time in one season, they will lose privileges up to a year, depending on severity.

Spectator Guidelines

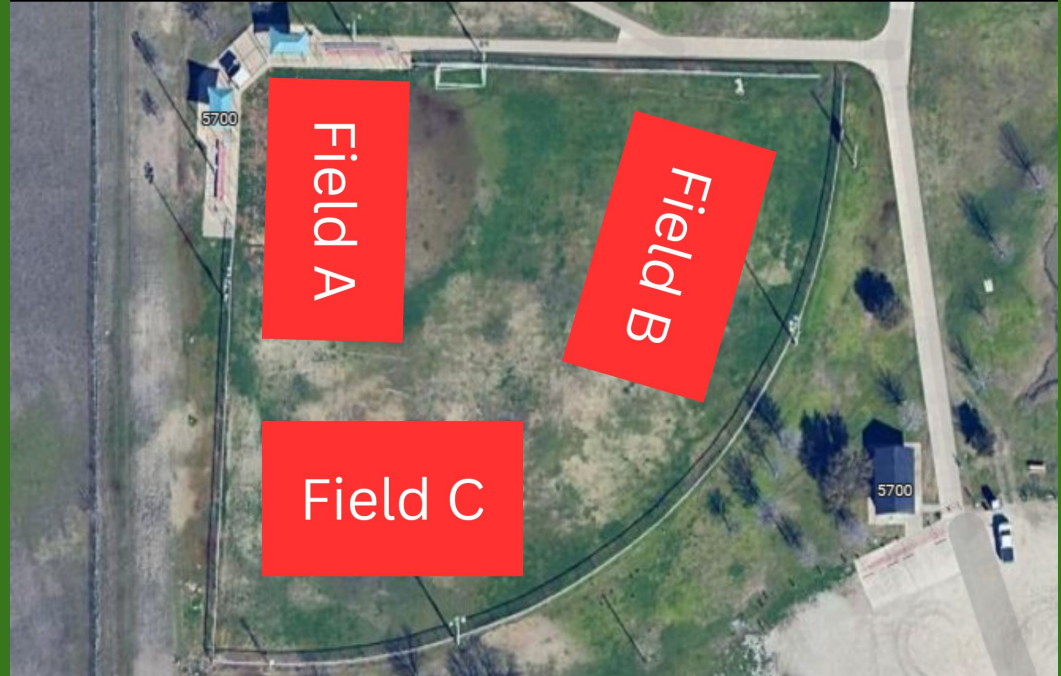
- Spectator Code of Conduct - Every participant is required for their guardian to review and sign the Spectator Code of Conduct. The child will not be able to play if this is not signed.
 - Review and sign the spectator code of conduct
- As the coach you are ultimately responsible for any actions of your parents.
 - All spectators must stay on the spectator sideline during the game. Only background check approved coaches may be on the team bench.
 - Spectators must sit in the designated spectator areas.
 - Unsportsmanlike conduct from parents will not be tolerated. Depending on the severity of the conduct we will ask the individual to leave the facility. Play will not resume until they leave.
- The aforementioned suspensions will be the minimum penalty enforced and may be increased in each situation due to the severity of actions.

Practice Information

- **How many practices?**
 - Teams will have 2 practice per week (1 hour slots)
- **When can practices start?**
 - Practice can start the week of August 25th.
- **Where will practices be held?**
 - BB Owen Sports Complex - 5700 Squires Drive
 - All league practices will be held on the red field

Practice Information (CONTD.)

Practice Etiquette

- Please make sure you are sticking to your scheduled time and your scheduled location on the field. It is your responsibility as a coach to not go over your time and interfere with practices after yours or during yours.
- Please call us or email us ahead of time if you will not be having practice that day so we avoid having lights on if not needed.
- If it is not your team's practice day/time you are NOT permitted to be using the field. Any extra practices must go through the rental process with the Athletic Team. (Extra practices are not guaranteed and come with a fee)
- The only practice reschedules permitted are for field closures. We will not reschedule for any other reasons.
- All music played during your practice must remain PG-13.

Field Status Information

It is the responsibility of the coach to check field status on the days of your practice to determine if the field is playable.

How do I check the field status?

When is practice field status updated?

- Field status is updated daily at 3:30pm if needed.
- We wait until 3:30pm the day of to update field status because a field could be not playable in the morning, but playable by 3:30pm. Weather is UNPREDICTABLE so we want to give teams the most chance to practice and play. It is up to you if you want to cancel practice prior to the status being updated.

Notifications:

You can sign up for text, email or push notifications. Anytime a status change happens you will get notified.

Field Lights Information

When do lights turn on for practices?

- All athletic field lights with rentals are set to turn on 30 minutes prior to sunset (Exception: If the rental starts after 30 minutes prior to sunset. Then the lights will be set for 15 minutes prior to the first reservation on that field.
 - This means you might have lights partially or for your whole practice depending on when sunset is on that specific day.
 - Example: Your practice is 7 - 8pm and sunset is 7:45pm. This means lights will come on at 7:15pm.

What if lights do not come at the scheduled time?

- Please call the main line at 972-625-1106. Staff will be able to help troubleshoot the issue.
- The main line is answered until 9pm on weekdays.

Game Information

- **When is the first weekend of games?**
 - September 13th
- **Where are games played?**
 - Strike Middle School located at 8798 Scotty's Lake Lane, The Colony, Texas 75056
 - There is a possibility we will be playing at Turner, but our goal is to play at Strike.
- **How many games for the season?**
 - Teams will be scheduled 6 games
- **Who makes the playoffs?**
 - The top 4 teams in each division will make the playoffs.
- **Will there be double headers or bye weeks?**
 - There will be double headers or bye weeks depending on the amount of teams in each division.

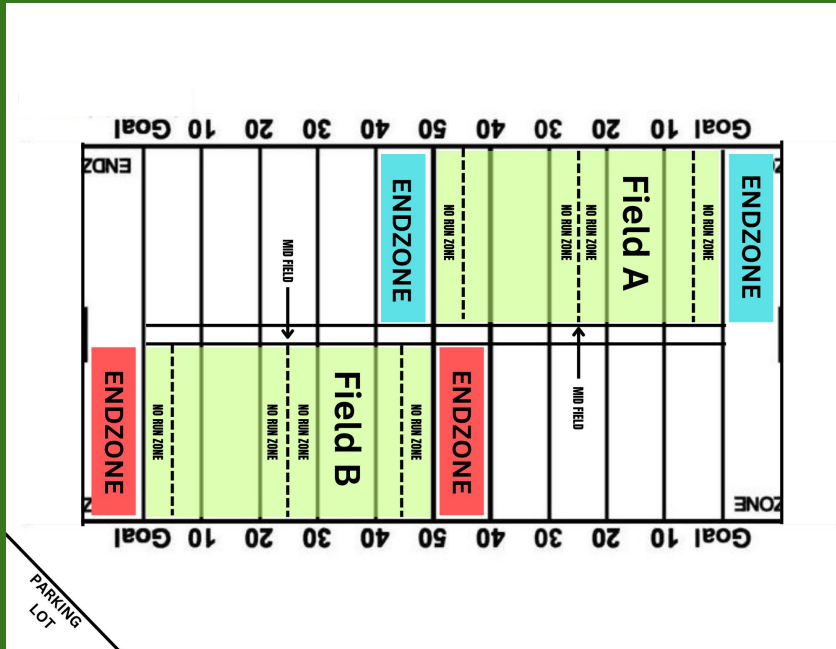
Game Schedule

- We will **not** take any request or make changes after the game schedule is posted.

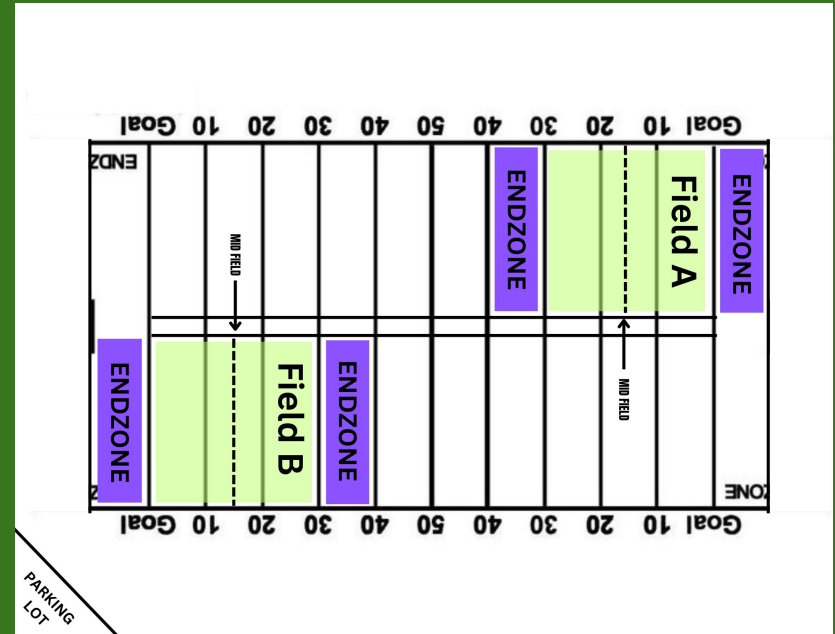

Strike Field Layout

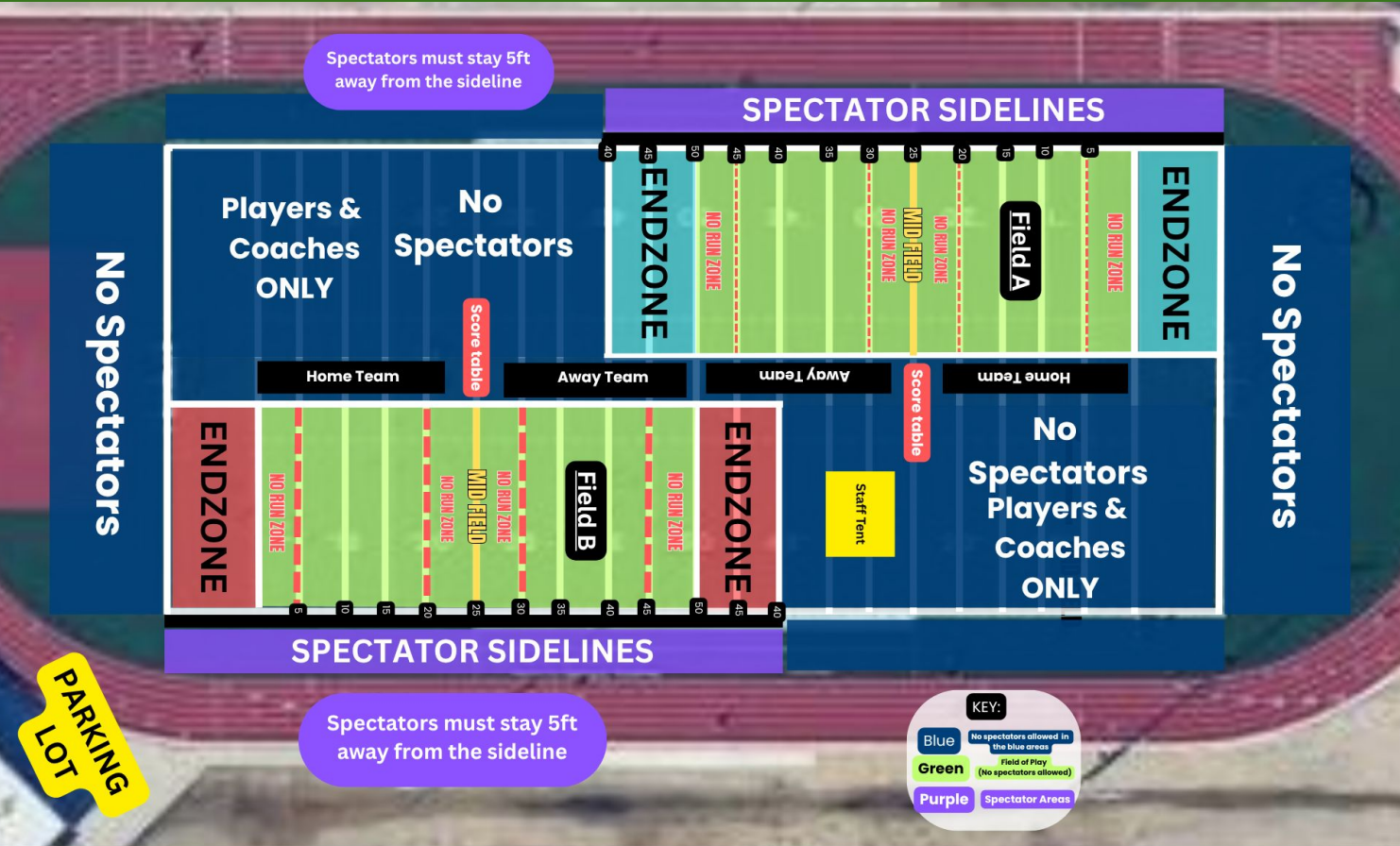

Spectators are not allowed in the blue areas on this map or on the playing field. If a spectator goes in the areas they will be asked to move to the spectator sideline. Not following these policies will result in the spectator to be asked to leave.

Game Day Information

- **Team Benches:** Home Team sits on the right side of the score table and the Away Team sits on the left side of the score table. An easy way to remember this is to look at the scoreboard and sit on the sideline closest to what team you are.
- **Jersey Color:**
 - Home Team - Lighter Color
 - Away Team - Darker Color
- **Coaching on Sideline:** Coaches need to remain in their team bench area only. A coach should not cross past the scoretable in the other team's bench area.
- **Coaches should not communicate with players from the opposing team in any capacity.**
- **Coaches should not be speaking to the other teams coaches unless it is in a positive manner.**

- Format - 4v4
- Ball Size - Pee Wee
- Game Length - Two 15 minute halves
- Field - L 50 YDS x W 30 YDS (10 YDS End Zone)
- Timeout - Two 60 second timeout per game
- NO Blitzing/Rushing
- Coaches allowed on field for offense and defense

8U Division

- Format - 5v5
- Ball Size - Pee Wee
- Game Length - Two 20 minute halves
- Field - L 70 YDS x W 30 YDS (10 YDS End Zone)
- Timeout - Two 60 second timeout per game
- Blitz/Rushing allowed
- Coaches allowed on field for offense and defense

10U Division

- Format - 5v5
- Ball Size - Junior/Youth
- Game Length - Two 20 minute halves
- Field - L 70 YDS x W 30 YDS (10 YDS End Zone)
- Timeout - Two 60 second timeout per game
- Blitz/Rushing Allowed
- **NO DEFENSIVE COACH AFTER THE 3RD WEEK OF GAMES**

12U Division

- Format - 5v5
- Ball Size - Junior/Youth
- Game Length - Two 20 minute halves
- Field - L 70 YDS x W 30 YDS (10 YDS End Zone)
- Timeout - Two 60 second timeout per game
- Blitz/Rushing Allowed
- **NO DEFENSIVE COACH AFTER THE 3RD WEEK OF GAMES**

Highlighted Rules - League Wide

- **Time Outs**

- Each team will receive two 60 second timeouts per game.
- When calling a time out, you must get the attention of the referee on the field. The scorekeeper or staff cannot stop the game for a timeout. The referee has to acknowledge the timeout prior to the clock stopping.

- **Clock**

- The clock will run continuously. The clock will only stop for time-outs, injuries, and on each whistle during the last 10 seconds of the second half. During the last 10 seconds of the second half the clock will start when the ball is snapped.

- **Overtime**

- No overtime will be played during the regular season if games end in a tie.
- Overtime will be played in the playoffs.

Highlighted Rules - League Wide

- **On the field coaching**

- For 10U and 12U after the third week of games the offensive coach will only be allowed on the field to assist.
- All other divisions coaches an offensive and defensive coach will be allowed throughout the season.

- **No Run Zones**

- There are no run zones located 5 yards before each end zone and 5 yards on either side of the midfield. Once inside this zone all plays must be pass plays, even with a handoff.
- No rushing/blitzing is allowed in the no run zones.
- 6U will not have no run zones.

- **Possessions**

- **The offensive team will have 4 downs to reach or cross the half field line. Once the offense reaches or crosses half field they will have 3 more downs to score.**

- **PAT**


- **After scoring a touchdown you must declare to the referee if you will be attempting a 1 or 2 point conversion.**
- **1 point = 5 yard line**
- **2 point = 10 yard line**

- **Interceptions**

- **All interceptions can be returned**

Playing Requirements

- Each player in attendance must play a **minimum** of two series per half.
 - A series consists of a full offensive or defensive series. (4 downs to advance at least 10 yards)



If this becomes an issue, then we will go back to the series tracker that the coaches will have to fill out

Please remember this is a recreational league! Our main goal is to teach these kids the basic fundamentals of football and for them to enjoy the sport.

Jerseys/Attire

- The league will provide each player with an NFL jersey.
- We do **NOT** have a stock of jerseys. This means we order jerseys specifically for each roster for the season. We use the jersey sizes directly from players registration.
- If a player loses a jersey or the jersey size they ordered does NOT fit, they would have to purchase a new one. The cost would be \$30 + Shipping.
- We complete our order after registration is completed so we will not have the jerseys and flags immediately to be picked up. We will send out an email as soon as we receive our order and the jerseys are ready to be picked up.
- Shorts must have no pockets. (Suggestion soccer shorts)
- No towels or rags may be worn during the game.



Flag Belts

- **Flag Belts**

- The league will provide each player with an NFL Flag belt.
- Please make sure your team trim their belts after receiving them. The belts are made for all sizes so we run into the issue of the belt being super long and looking like a third flag.
- Our goal is to have them to you the first week of practices, but we do have to order them with the jerseys. Due to this we have to wait until registration has completed to submit our order and sometimes there are delays.
- We will not have extra flag belts at the games, so please make sure your players bring them to the game!
- The officials will do flag checks, prior to each game.
- Please make sure your having your players adjust their flags to their hips before every play to ensure they are in the correct position.

We will send out an email when these orders arrive!

Other Equipment

Mouthguards

- All players **MUST** be wearing a mouthguard during play.
- The league does not provide mouthguards. We do offer for people to purchase them during registration.
- Prior to the game the referees will do a mouthguard check.
- If a player does not have a mouthguard they will not be able to play until they have one.
- We will **NOT** have a stock of mouthguards at games.

Balls

- The league will provide each team with at least one ball for your team for the season.
- We receive an allotted amount of balls from NFL Flag depending on the amount of jerseys we order. This determines how many we would be able to give to each team.
- We receive these when we receive the jersey order.

Sportsmanship Initiative

- What is this initiative?
 - The sportsmanship initiative was created for us to be able to celebrate those players that have truly shown great sportsmanship through the season. With this initiative we are hoping to inspire players, coaches, and spectators to always show good sportsmanship.
- How does this initiative work?
 - The head coach of each team will nominate two players during the season. One for the first half of the season and one for the second half of the season.
 - **1st Nomination Deadline: 9/22/2025**
 - **2nd Nomination Deadline: 10/6/2025**
- It is not mandatory for you to submit a nominee, but we highly suggest you participate! We have received questions from parents in the past when someone is not nominated from a team. In these cases we will tell them that the head coach did not participate.
- What does the player get?
 - A certificate, name added to the website and we also email the nominees league wide

Head Coach Reimbursement

Head coaches are eligible to receive a 50% registration reimbursement.

How do I qualify?

- Attend the Coaches Meeting (If you cannot attend the coaches meeting, attend one of the parent meetings)
- Paperwork Completed
 - Background Check
 - Coaches Code of Conduct
 - Volunteer Arrest Waiver
- NAYS Training Completed by Deadline **(9/12/2025)**
- Completed the full season without any disciplinary issues/concerns **(If you are ejected during the season you will not receive the reimbursement)**

* These reimbursements will be processed after the season has been completed.

- “While I was at the complex I saw a coach completely dressing down a young man it was not acceptable.”
- “Always should be about the kids having fun and learning. Not about the male coaching having a pee match. And recruiting kids underneath other coaches just for speed”
- “Coaching was not great. Location of practice fields changed with no notice because it’s closer to the coaches house. Many were cancelled with little notice and the coaching staff didn’t show up till game time nearly every week. Would not sign up for the same team again.”

- Why do we not use LISD fields? - We do not use LISD fields due to the cost of reserving and the limited availability.
